System Calibration Prior to Certification Test (Pre-Calibration Test)

- Prior to trying certification, analyze HbA1c values in the pre-calibration test material for NGSP certification (1 set: 10 vials) shipped together with 40 specimens for certification test. This process intends to be a system calibration.
- 2 Then inform ASRL#1 (<u>ngspdata@reccs.net</u>) of your measurement results.
- ③ A calibration equation is given to you by return by email.
- If your bias is over 0.2% HbA1c, your calibrator values should be corrected to produce non-bias values. If you correct your calibrator to pass the certification test, the corrected values should be assigned to your calibrator. If the amount of correction is less than <0.2% HbA1c, the correction is at your choice.
 ※your bias correction is recommended to avoid user's confusion.
- (5) Proceed to the certification test according to NGSP Manufacturer Certification Information or NGSP Level I, Level II Laboratory Certification Information (See them at Type of NGSP Certification).
